

STATEMENT OF THE PROBLEM

The Weott Community Services District currently only has a capacity to hold an approximate 3 day water supply for its customers. In the event of a severe drought or emergency situation, this supply is not sufficient. The District operates at a loss or very small profit each year and cannot afford such expenditures.

PROJECT GOALS

Water supply reliability for a state-recognized Disadvantaged Community

THE SOLUTION

This project will plan for and design a 500,000 gallon steel tank, which would boost water storage capacity to 30 days, which would be sufficient to deal with most emergencies.

PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

This project has been completed; a site for the water tank has been identified and project design and CEQA documentation have been completed.

PROJECT BUDGET

IRWM funds: \$ 75,000 TOTAL \$ 75,000

BENEFITS

This project is a planning project; the benefits listed below are expected upon completion of tank construction.

Economic benefits

 Approximately \$19,500 in avoided costs of water shortages will be realized during years in which drought conditions are extreme

Cultural benefits

- Climate resiliency for the town of Weott through a diversified water supply, which will allow for more efficient use of water and buffer the community against prolonged drought, increased heat events, and firefighting
- Continued economic viability through improving water supply services to area businesses and campgrounds

Jobs and Local Economic Benefits

- Approximately \$75,000 spent locally using local supplies and labor when possible
- About 1 job created/maintained

The Weott CSD will seek funding to implement storage tank construction.
