- To Vote and/or Nominate Representatives this Nomination Form and a supporting Tribal Resolution is due on June 26, 2023 at 5pm by email to [sherri@cieaweb.org](mailto:sherri@cieaweb.org)
- The next Tribal NCRP Meeting on June 27, 2023 begins at 10am in Fort Bragg or online, that is where your identified Voting Delegate will assist in selecting new Leadership Council and TPRC Representatives for your District.
- The next Quarterly NCRP Meeting July 13 – 14, 2023. If your Representative is selected they should be prepared to attend this meeting. The first day is strategic planning so you do not want to miss it!

This '*Nomination Form*' is for Tribal Councils to nominate a person, or persons to join the governance bodies of the North Coast Resource Partnership (NCRP).

The NCRP is the regional body originally created to manage the funding from the state's Integrated Regional Water Management (IRWM) program. County and Tribal Representatives make up the Leadership Council, the decision-making body of the NCRP. North Coast Tribes conduct their own selection process for Tribal representation.

Tribal seats within the North Coast region consist of three (3) Leadership Council seats and three (3) Technical Peer Review Committee seats, and an alternate for each. This means there is a team of twelve (12) Tribal Representatives making decisions by consensus, and then three (3) Leadership Council representatives join county Representatives in the at Quarterly and Executive Committee meetings to guide the NCRP.

Decision making alongside the seated County representatives requires a quorum is present; therefore a Tribal Representatives from each District or their Alternates are responsible to attend all meetings for the Leadership Council and/or TPRC seat for which they were nominated.

If Representatives are unable to attend a meeting, they must inform their Alternate and the Tribal Engagement Coordinator at least two (2) weeks prior to the meeting to make arrangements for Alternate or TPRC participation. This will ensure that Tribal Representatives are at the table for decision-making.
